Please note:

Some supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year such as notebook paper, pencils and pens. Elective classes may have additional minimum requirements determined by the nature of the elective, and other supplies may be required by teachers on an “as needed” basis for special projects or labs. Some supplies are taken up from students and become part of a “communal supply,” and others will remain the property of the student and be kept in the student’s binder or a classroom storage space.



Devine Middle School P.E. Class Uniform & Labeling Requirements

Dressing out on a daily basis is a requirement of physical education to enhance motor development and also for the purposes of hygiene and safety. If a student fails to bring his/her P.E. clothes, 20 points will be deducted from the weekly "Dress-Out" grade. Students are required to dress out Monday through Friday, unless otherwise instructed. Exceptions may be made for school assemblies, class business meetings, or the P.E.

class meeting in a regular classroom for health instruction. Students are expected to bring clean clothes every Monday and take home dirty clothes to wash every Friday.

Warning: The locker rooms are sanitized every Friday, and clothes left behind risk being ruined by the bleach solution and other chemicals that are used to wash down the area, including the lockers themselves. It is very important that students remember to retrieve their gym clothes every Friday to take home.

Required Uniform:

- White t-shirt** (plain Hanes or Fruit of the Loom undershirts work best)
- Maroon, gold, gray or black athletic-style shorts** (no blue jean shorts or cut-offs; shorts must stay up at the waist with elastic and/or drawstring)
- Socks** (must be worn at all times with shoes)
- Tennis shoes** (must be laced/tied securely on the feet at all times)
- Towel** (optional)
- DURING COLDER DAYS (Thanksgiving to Spring Break only): solid-colored warm-up pants are allowed to be worn over or in place of shorts** (No pajama pants allowed. Nothing should be written on the pants, especially not across the "rear end.")

Labeling Requirements: Use a black Sharpie or Rub-a-Dub marker that will not disappear when washed to label all items. Some students and their parents choose to go to a local t-shirt shop and have the first initial and last name ironed on. Expect to pay between 20 to 30 cents per letter, depending upon where you have it done. One local shop will also put a small Devine logo on the shirts as part of a "package deal," and this is acceptable. Instructors will have markers to label clothing. Come with it done correctly, or expect it to be done for you by the coach.

- Last name, first initial on top left side of shirt**
- Last name, first initial on left leg of short at hem**
- Three initials inside tongue of both tennis shoes**
- Last name, first initial on towel**
